We suggest that you have most of your pictures taken before the service. This helps you arrive at the reception in a timely manner. We have beautiful grounds with lots of attractive settings for photographs. Because they are so distracting, no flash pictures are permitted inside the Church during the wedding. Also, if the ceremony is being videoed, no spotlights are allowed in the Church. Pictures may be taken in the Church after all guests have left, but we encourage you to direct your photographer to take as many pictures before the wedding as possible. You will be able to take your pictures as soon as the Church is cleared and be off to your reception without delaying your guests too long. After the ceremony, photos involving the clergy should be taken first.

7. A wedding coordinator might assist you on your wedding day; however, s/he will have no authority over the Church ceremony.

#### 8. Premarital Counseling

Before your wedding, the couple will meet with the Rector for pre-marital preparation, usually about three sessions, required by the rules of the Church. It will be helpful to you to have had this preparation completed far in advance of the wedding. If you live out of town and are active members of an Episcopal Church, the clergy here will help you make special arrangements for the pre-marital counseling with your own priest. Your priest will need to provide a letter to the Rector of St. Michael's indicating you have completed the required preparation.

### 9.LGBTQ+ Weddings

The Episcopal Church is proud to be one of the first mainstream Christian churches that not only allows, but celebrates marriage between couples under the LGBTQ+ umbrella. Just as Christ welcomed all, we too welcome all.

### **10.Divorced Persons**

In the Episcopal Church, no priest is permitted to preside at the wedding of a divorced person without the consent of the Bishop. A request for permission for re-marriage of a divorced person must be sent by the clergy to the Bishop at least 30 days prior to the wedding. It is a further requirement in our Diocese that we have a copy of any applicable divorce decree that shows its finality at least one year prior to the remarriage. The Rector will fill the form out with your during pre-marital counseling.

11. A leaflet bulletin must be printed and include one for each anticipated attendee (please make a few extras copies). The purpose of the bulletin is to contain the texts of the hymns, the Scripture readings and the Lord's Prayer.
